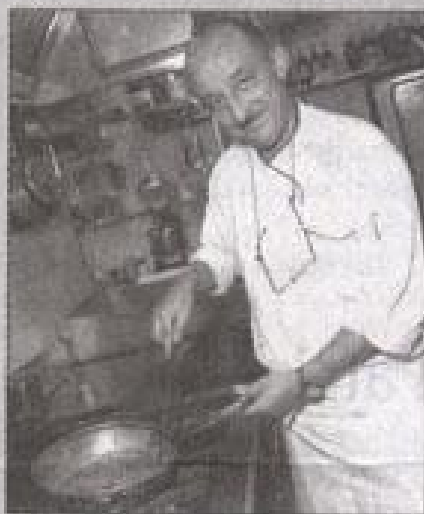


## The keys to culinary success
